RWC 2011 Team Hosting Announcement

Background information

The Objective

Rugby New Zealand 2011 Ltd (RNZ 2011) is committed to spreading Rugby World Cup 2011 (RWC 2011) around New Zealand, to give as many communities as is reasonably possible the chance to experience the excitement of the Tournament, and through this, to truly bring to life New Zealand's "Stadium of Four Million".

The match scheduling decisions announced, in September 2008 and March 2009, and the ticketing pricing decision in December 2009 underlined that commitment; likewise, RNZ 2011's decision to initiate the creation of a RWC 2011 Festival, to be wrapped around the core Tournament.

This Team Hosting announcement will reinforce our commitment to ensuring many communities, big and small, across New Zealand, can share in the RWC 2011 experience.

Background

As part of a three stage process, in May 2008 a match venue, training venue and team hosting specification was developed by RNZ 2011 and approved by Rugby World Cup Ltd. This specification was then circulated by RNZ 2011 to 22 Regional Coordination Groups which had expressed an interest in their regions hosting matches or teams during RWC 2011.

The first two stages of this process, relating to match schedule, have been completed with the confirmation of the knockout match venues in September 2008 and the pool match venues in March 2009.

This Team Hosting announcement completes the third stage of this process

The Approach

Initially, RNZ 2011's structure for the Team Hosting process was provisionally modelled on the system that was adopted for RWC 2007 in France where teams were based in Host Cities for the majority of the pool phase of the Tournament, travelling to Host Cities the night before their match then returning to their Host City the day following the match.

Feedback from the participating teams demonstrated a clear preference to travel from region to region for their matches rather than being based in one host city for the duration of their stay.

Representatives from most qualified teams have also visited New Zealand to see the centres, facilities and accommodation options available to them.

A range of criteria was applied to assess options. For example:

- All accommodation options on match days will be a maximum of 50 minutes drive from the match venue
- All training facilities will be a maximum of 30 minutes drive from team accommodation

- Enduring benefits: how much of a catalyst for facility improvement as a result of the allocation of a team
- Cost containment - minimising the cost of domestic air travel

In making the final allocation decision RNZ 2011 has endeavoured to find the right balance between team preferences as well as delivering against the Tournament objectives.

The allocation of accommodation and training venues for the knockout phase of the Tournament will be determined by ballot for the teams that qualify and will be located in the cities hosting these matches (Christchurch and Wellington for the quarter-finals and Auckland for the semi-finals, Bronze Final and Final).

Team Hosting Key Facts

- 20 teams are participating in RWC 2011, four have yet to qualify
- Teams are based in 23 centres – 16 North Island, 7 South Island
- There are 10 non-match centres
- Duration of stay in each centre: 2 to 25 nights
- Teams practice at 47 training venues which include:
 - 18 Rugby clubs
 - 7 schools
- Average team size: 45 players and support staff
- First teams arrive August 31, 2011
